A tolerance of +1 MT (One Metric Tonne) per vehicle is allowed over the permissible loading limit. However, if the weight of the vehicle, as recorded at the TSPL weighbridge, exceeds the permissible loading limit (MT) + 1 MT, payment will be made only for the quantity up to:</p> <p>Allowable Weight for making payment = (Permissible limit +1 MT) or Actual Net weight (Whichever is less)</p> <p>For example, if the permissible loading limit of a vehicle is 35 tonnes and the recorded actual weight at the TSPL weighbridge is 38 tonnes, the overload is 3 tonnes. In this case, the allowable weight for making payment shall be 35 +1 =36 MT only. The payment to the supplier shall be restricted to this quantity (36 MT) only.</p>
