- **43 out of 50 TB patients successfully complete treatment following six months of nutritional support**

Mansa, Punjab | June 11, 2026: Vedanta Power Talwandi Sabo Thermal Plant, Punjab's largest thermal power plant located at village Banawala, has successfully completed a six-month nutritional support initiative for tuberculosis (TB) patients under the Prime Minister's TB-Free India Campaign and PM Nikshay Mitra Yojana. As a result of the initiative, 43 beneficiaries have successfully completed their treatment and have been declared TB-free, while the remaining seven patients continue to undergo treatment.

Launched at Civil Hospital, Mansa in Nov 2025 this initiative has achieved a significant milestone in strengthening Vedanta Power Talwandi Sabo Thermal Plant's engagement with the community and supporting the Government of India's mission to eliminate TB. Under its CSR initiative 'SEHAT' with the slogan 'TB Hatao, Desh Bachao', the plant provided nutritional support to 50 TB patients for six months, the monthly nutrition kits included protein-rich pulses, legumes, soy-based supplements, and edible oil required to increase calorie and protein intake, ensuring that patients received the necessary nutritional support during their treatment.
