Meenakshi Energy Strengthens Women's Preventive Healthcare Access Through Project Arogya

Nellore, July 14, 2026: Reinforcing its commitment to community healthcare and women's well-being, Vedanta Power Meenakshi Energy Limited organised a Medical Camp on 30th June 2026 at Thamminapatnam Panchayat under its flagship Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiative, Project Arogya.

The camp conducted in collaboration with Jayabharathy Hospital, Nellore in Andhra Pradesh focused on promoting women's health through preventive screenings, medical consultations and treatment for Reproductive Tract Infections (RTIs), anaemia and other gynaecological health concerns. The full-day camp witnessed over 100 women beneficiaries availing healthcare services.

A team of medical professionals from Jayabharathy Hospital, including Gynecology specialists and General physicians, conducted comprehensive health screenings, offered medical consultations, and distributed medicines free of cost to beneficiaries. The initiative was aimed at enhancing access to quality healthcare services in rural communities, promoting early detection and timely treatment of health conditions, and raising awareness about preventive healthcare practices among women.
